
- Identified 24 corridors for potential investments in high-capacity transit.








Countywide Transit Strategies


- South Orange County Multimodal Transportation Study
 - I-5 BRT, Project V circulators, mobility hubs, expanded bike network, TDM strategies
- Metrolink SCORE Program
 - Long-term plan to increase passenger rail frequencies
 - Consider increasing OC Bus service to connect with additional rail trips
- Transit Oriented Development Opportunities
 - Fullerton Park & Ride, OC Vibe, OC River Walk, Doheny Village/Dana Point
- Mobility Hubs Strategy
 - 41 potential locations for multimodal transit connections
- Monitor high-growth areas for potential new/increased OC Bus service
 - Disneyland Forward plan, Rancho Mission Viejo, Irvine














