- Mitigation Program part of 2007 Early Action Plan (EAP)
- Acquisition and Restoration
- M2-approved November 2006 Innovative Freeway Environmer







- Approximately five percent of the M2 freeway program revenue
- Mitigation off-sets impacts for 13 M2 freeway projects
  - » Through property acquisitions and habitat restoration
- Streamlined biological permitting process through partnerships with California Department of Transportation and state and federal wildlife agencies

- Seven Preserves acquired as permanent open space
  - 1,300 acres
- Eleven restoration projects
  - 400 acres
  - Replacing invasive plant
    species with native habitat


Acquisition and Restoration















- Approved in November 2016
- Natural Community Conservation Plan/Habitat Conservation Plan (NCCP/HCP)
  - Integrates acquired properties and restoration projects
  - Implementing agreement
- Environmental Impact Report/Environmental Impact Statement
  - Public participation opportunities
  - Solidifies decision on the project





- Identify and fund new restoration projects to fulfill NCCP/HCP requirements
- Conduct monitoring and provide annual reports
- Access opportunities
- Designate long-term land managers
