Google Detour Map Tutorial





Overview

As part OCTA's outreach efforts on the I-5 South County Improvement Project, the project team plots all nightly closures on a <u>Google Map</u> so you are never stuck in a jam!

This interactive map is updated in real time and is easily accessible on your smart phone. You also can bookmark the page on your computer and it allows you to see other local detour routes that may be convenient for your commute.

Keep scrolling to view a step by step tutorial on how to access and print each week's closures!

- To access the map, visit <u>www.octa.net/I-5Pico</u> and click on the Google Map icon.
- You can also access the map at <u>www.octa.net/5southCountyDetourmap</u>



This is what you should see when the Google Map opens in your browser. If you do not see the plotted points immediately, zoom out until they appear on your page.



To view the closures and suggested detours, simply click on one of the plotted points, you can also scroll down the list on the lefthand side of the page.



To print the closures and detours, select the printer icon on the left side of the page. This will open a "Print Preview" in a separate window.
