

LAKEVIEW AVENUE OVERCROSSING



AT A GLANCE

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OCTA has reconstructed Lakeview Avenue, from south of Orchard Drive to south of Eisenhower Circle, as a bridge to allow vehicles to pass over the Burlington Northern Santa Fe Railway. As part of the project, Lakeview Avenue has been raised and realigned to allow separation of car traffic from train traffic. A connector road linking Lakeview Avenue and Orangethorpe Avenue also was constructed, and North Bubach Street on the northeast corner of the project area has been rerouted to connect to the connector road with a new signalized intersection. In addition, a new frontage road was built on the southeast corner of the project for local business access. A new road also was built on the southwest corner to connect the new frontage road to Lakeview Avenue.

CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE

Construction of the Lakeview Avenue overcrossing began in mid-2014 and the new bridge opened to motorists on June 6, 2017. While the bridge is open, finishing work may be required through summer of 2017.

OCTA's highest priority is safety for its project workers and the public. As crews finalize construction activities, please continue to:

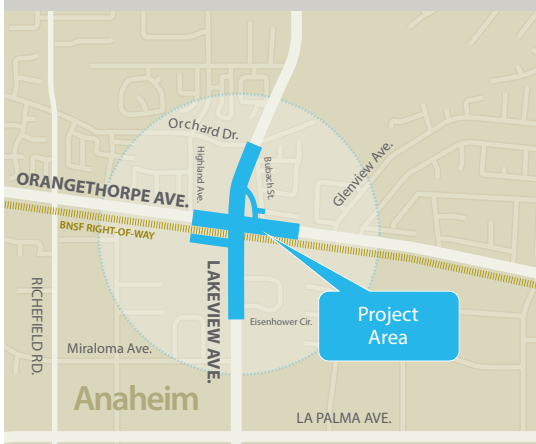
- Slow down and watch for workers and equipment

MAJOR PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- New bridge structure over Burlington Northern Santa Fe Railway
- New frontage and access road for businesses between Orangethorpe Avenue and Atwood channel
- Installation of traffic signals at:
 - Connector Road and Lakeview Avenue
 - Bubach Street and Connector Road
 - Eisenhower Circle and Lakeview Avenue
 - Via de Comercial and Lakeview Avenue
 - Highland Avenue and Orangethorpe Avenue
- New road configuration into Bubach St. neighborhood
- Landscaping improvements
- Sidewalk improvements
