Project Overview


- Measure M2 Project A
 - \$42.4 million
 - Funding: Measure M, Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Improvement Program, and State Transportation Improvement Program

Proposed Improvements:

- Add second high-occupancy vehicle (HOV) lane in each direction on I-5 between SR-55 and SR-57
- Remove the Main Street on- and off-ramps

Project Benefits:

- Reduce Congestion
- Eliminate bottlenecks at HOV merge points
- Improve Air Quality










Existing Condition Cross Section










Proposed Condition Cross Section

Add 2nd HOV Lane


