A valid **Medicare** card must be presented with a photo ID in person or a copy of your Medicare card and ID must be submitted with your application.
- DMV DISABLED PLACARD RECEIPT**
Valid registration receipt for a DMV disabled placard must be presented with a photo ID in person or a copy and ID must be submitted with your application.
- SERVICE CONNECTED VETERAN ID CARD**
- BRAILLE INSTITUTE IDENTIFICATION CARD**

Applicants applying by mail will be issued an approval notice by mail in approximately 10 - 14 business days upon review of their application. Once an approval notice is received, applicants can come to the OCTA Store Monday through Friday between 8AM-5PM with a valid ID card to pick up their ID Card. If an application is denied, the applicant will receive a written notification that will include the reason(s) for denial. Applicants may then correct applications or appeal denial of eligibility within 14 days of the date of denial notice.
