



#### AASHTO Bicycle Facilities Guide




- \$120 \$150 print or pdf
- 2012 Edition (prev.1999)
- Developed by State DOTs
- Used with Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD)
- Most conservative guidance
- No Buffered Bike Lanes

### NACTO Urban Bikeway Design Guide



- Free
- 1st Ed. 2011, 2nd Ed. 2012
- Developed by member city transportation officials
- Adopted by Caltrans, Los Angeles, Oakland, & San Francisco
- Supported by FHWA


### Model Design Manual for Living Streets
