The Tustin train station was built in 2002 and is conveniently located near residential neighborhoods, employment centers and shopping destinations in Tustin, Irvine and Newport Beach. Today an average of more than 1,110 Metrolink passengers board trains at the Tustin station each weekday. This number is expected to grow steadily as the adjacent Tustin Legacy development on the former 1,600 acre Marine Corps Air Station continues to advance. From Tustin, Orange County's Metrolink service offers local residents an alternative way to get to work, school or fun destinations in Los Angeles, parts of north and south Orange County, Riverside and San Diego.
