## OCTA Board Approves 405 Express Lanes Toll Policy

OCTA's board approved an update to the toll policy for the 405 Express Lanes, which is being built as part of the I-405 Improvement Project.

The 405 Express Lanes – between SR-73 in Costa Mesa and I-605 at the Orange County Line – will give options to carpoolers to travel for free and solo drivers the choice to speed up their commute for a toll. The tolls will vary by hour, day of the week, direction of travel, and distance traveled, and will be adjusted regularly to ensure a free-flowing commute.

The toll policy helps meet the OCTA Board's goals for the 405 Express Lanes, including providing drivers with a safe, reliable commute and maximizing the number of vehicles that travel at free-flow speeds.

The overall \$2.1 billion I-405 Improvement Project is currently 95% complete and all improvements are scheduled to open to traffic in late 2023.
