#### **Need for Fare Adjustment**

- Declining Farebox Recovery
  - Transportation Development Act 20% mandate
  - Declining farebox revenue
    - Decrease in fare revenue from \$54.6M in fiscal year (FY) 2008-09 to \$50.6M in FY 2011-12
  - Rising costs
    - Increase in cost per service hour from \$98.01 in FY 2008-09 to \$108.20 in FY 2011-12
- Revenue Enhancement
  - Necessary to meet operating expenses
  - Balance the FY 2012-13 budget
- Support long term service viability

# **Goals for Fare Adjustment**

- Maintain Farebox Recovery
  - Transportation Development Act 20% mandate
- Increase Revenue
  - Necessary to meet operating expenses
  - Balance FY 2012-13 budget
  - Support long term service viability
  - Increase fare per boarding by 25%
- Minimize impact to customers and operations
- Ensure fare increase is equitable
