



#### Signal Synchronization Program Overview

- Competitive funding for local agencies
- Three-year grants for signal timing
- Local agencies lead, with OCTA option
- Local agencies contribute
- Regional projects that cross jurisdictions
  - Goal Coordinate at least 2,000 signals and 750 miles
