Narrower Lanes Now, Faster Travel Times Later on State Route 91

In early June, eastbound and westbound lanes on State Route 91 (SR-91) between State Route 71 (SR-71) and Main Street in Corona were reduced in width, creating a tighter squeeze for drivers. Each of the four inner lanes was trimmed to 10.5 feet across; the outer or "slow" lane will remain 12 feet wide. In addition, one-mile sections of the outer shoulder were removed in various locations. Called the Corona Squeeze, this configuration will remain for 10 months to allow crews room to work safely and widen the roadway.

That's a recent update from the Riverside County Transportation Commission (RCTC) regarding the 91 Project, which will add regular lanes, tolled express lanes and connectors and improve interchanges, bridges, and ramps from the Riverside County/Orange County line in Corona to Pierce Street in Riverside. Once completed, the 91 Project is expected to reduce traffic delays, offer choice and travel time certainty through tolled express lanes, allow faster

emergency response, relieve local street congestion, reduce air pollution and create new jobs.

During construction, RCTC will add an additional Freeway Service Patrol (FSP) tow truck to help stranded motorists and to clear accidents more quickly. Motorists are reminded to be alert to changing conditions and to always signal before changing lanes.

A Proven Team Helps Drivers Safely Go with the Flow

Drivers often choose the 91 Express Lanes because it offers a consistently flowing way to travel. The California Highway Patrol (CHP), Customer Assistance Patrol, and Traffic Operations Center work together to keep traffic moving smoothly and lend a hand if something slows you down.

The CHP helps ensure efficient traffic movement by reducing the number of traffic collisions and injuries while enforcing speed, carpool, and toll evasion violations. They watch for drivers following too closely, not wearing seat belts, and illegally entering and exiting. Officers check for vehicles with missing, covered or obscured license plates to avoid FasTrak™ billing and are on alert for vehicles in the "3+" carpool lane with less than three people. In addition, they stop vehicles that trigger the overhead violation enforcement lights if those vehicles do not have a properly displayed transponder.

The Customer Assistance Patrol works with the CHP to provide immediate help if

something troublesome occurs, such as a flat tire or empty gas tank. Using specially marked tow trucks and service vehicles, they patrol the toll lanes to provide quick assistance – and their services are totally free.

Another key player in our helpful team is the Traffic Operations Center, which uses in-road sensors and video cameras to monitor conditions on the 91 Express Lanes 24/7. When a problem is detected, the TOC quickly dispatches the Customer Assistance Patrol or contacts the CHP if the incident occurs after hours.

New Toll Adjustments Effective July 1, 2015

Each year, tolls not adjusted by congestion management pricing are subject to a cost-of-living adjustment (COLA) as specified by the toll policy approved by the OCTA Board of Directors.

Beginning July 1, tolls will increase 3 percent (rounded up or down to the nearest 0.05 cent increment). Please check the toll schedule at right for the latest toll adjustments.
