- \$25 million available
- Fiscal Years 2019-2020 through 2023-2024

Application Type	Available Funds	Minimum Request	Maximum Request
Environmental	\$2 million	\$100,000	\$500,000
Implementation	\$23 million	\$200,000	\$4 million

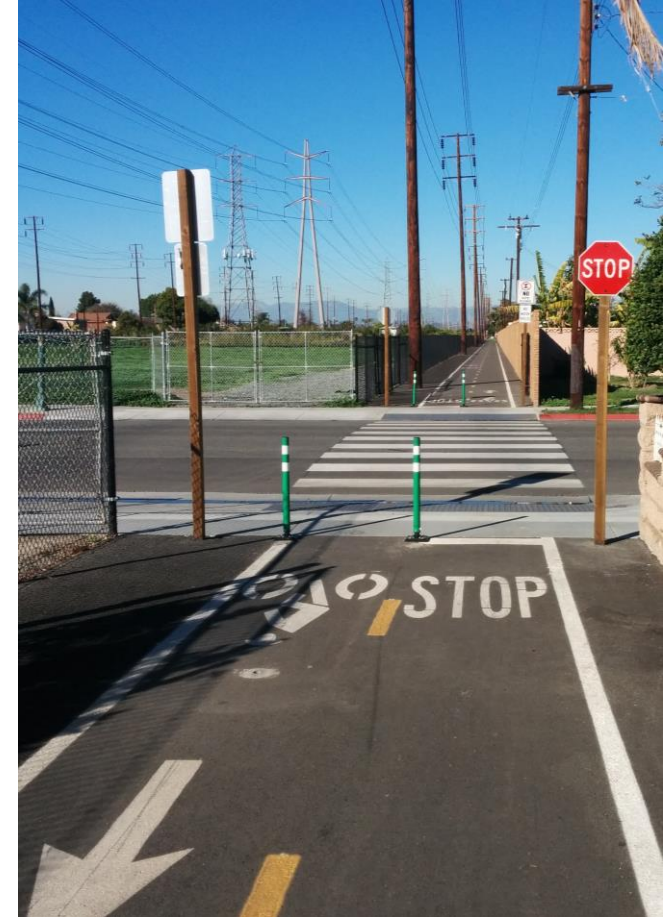
2019 BCIP - Eligible Phases

Eligible Environmental phases include:

- Environmental Documentation (in FY 2019-2020 only)
- Preliminary Engineering (up to 35%)

Eligible Implementation phases include:

- Final Design
- Right-of-Way
- Construction
