Staying Safe with the Customer Assistance Patrol

When you're driving on the 91 Express Lanes, it's reassuring to know that the Customer Assistance Patrol has your back.

Despite your best efforts, sometimes something-from rainstorms to wildfires to mechanical trouble-can slow you down. Fortunately, you can count on help from the 91 Express Lanes Customer Assistance Patrol.

This team of five Customer Assistance Specialists patrols the toll lanes with specially marked tow trucks and service vehicles and provides help to customers in need. Whether you're out of gas, have a flat tire, or need your vehicle towed to safety, the Customer Assistance Patrol gets there fast to help–and is totally free.

Every day, the 91 Express Lanes Traffic Operations Center (TOC) uses in-road sensors and video cameras to monitor conditions on the 91 Express Lanes, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. When a problem is detected, the TOC can quickly dispatch the Customer Assistance Patrol or contact the California Highway Patrol, if the incident occurs after hours.

What should you do if you need help? Whenever possible, pull over in one of the enforcement areas (the widened areas in the median) and turn on your flashing hazard lights. There are three enforcement areas along the Express Lanes; one between Coal Canyon Road and Gypsum Canyon Road; one at the toll zone–just beyond the overhead sign structure; and one between Imperial Highway and Weir Canyon Road.

If you can't reach an enforcement area, pull over to the far left shoulder and turn on your flashing hazard lights. The Customer Assistance Service Patrol will be dispatched to help you.

The 91 Express Lanes Customer Assistance Patrol is on duty weekdays from 5 a.m. to 9 p.m., Saturdays from 8 a.m. to 7 p.m., and Sundays from 8 a.m. to 9 p.m. It's just another way we're looking out for your driving safety– and helping to ensure your peace of mind.



The 91 Express Lanes Receives Milestone Bond Rating


Recently, the 91 Express Lanes received a ratings increase from Standard & Poor's (S&P), an independent rating agency that evaluates bond issuers. The new rating–"AA–" makes the 91 Express Lanes one of the only single-asset managed lanes toll facility in the "AA" category.

Why is that important? It indicates strong financial strength and shows that resources are available to continue maintaining and improving the 91 Express Lanes.

When OCTA took ownership of the 91 Express Lanes 11 years ago, it became the first singleasset lane entity to learn an "A" bond rating. It has maintained that rating every year until nowwhen the bond rating was upgraded.

The 91 Express Lanes remains fiscally strong in a challenging economy and continues to provide a transportation alternative you can count on.

Keep Your FasTrak[™] Transponder Handy for Travel on the 91 Express Lanes

Some Orange County toll roads have been in the news lately due to confusion over how tolls are paid.

But on the 91 Express Lanes, the process is straightforward and simple: To use the 91 Express Lanes, your vehicle must be equipped with a FasTrak transponder linked to a pre-paid account.

So keep your transponder handy when traveling on the 91 Express Lanes. You'll save an average of 30 minutes per trip while traveling in free-flowing lanes for 10 miles without stopping to pay tolls.
