- 2-year cycle | 6-year funding program

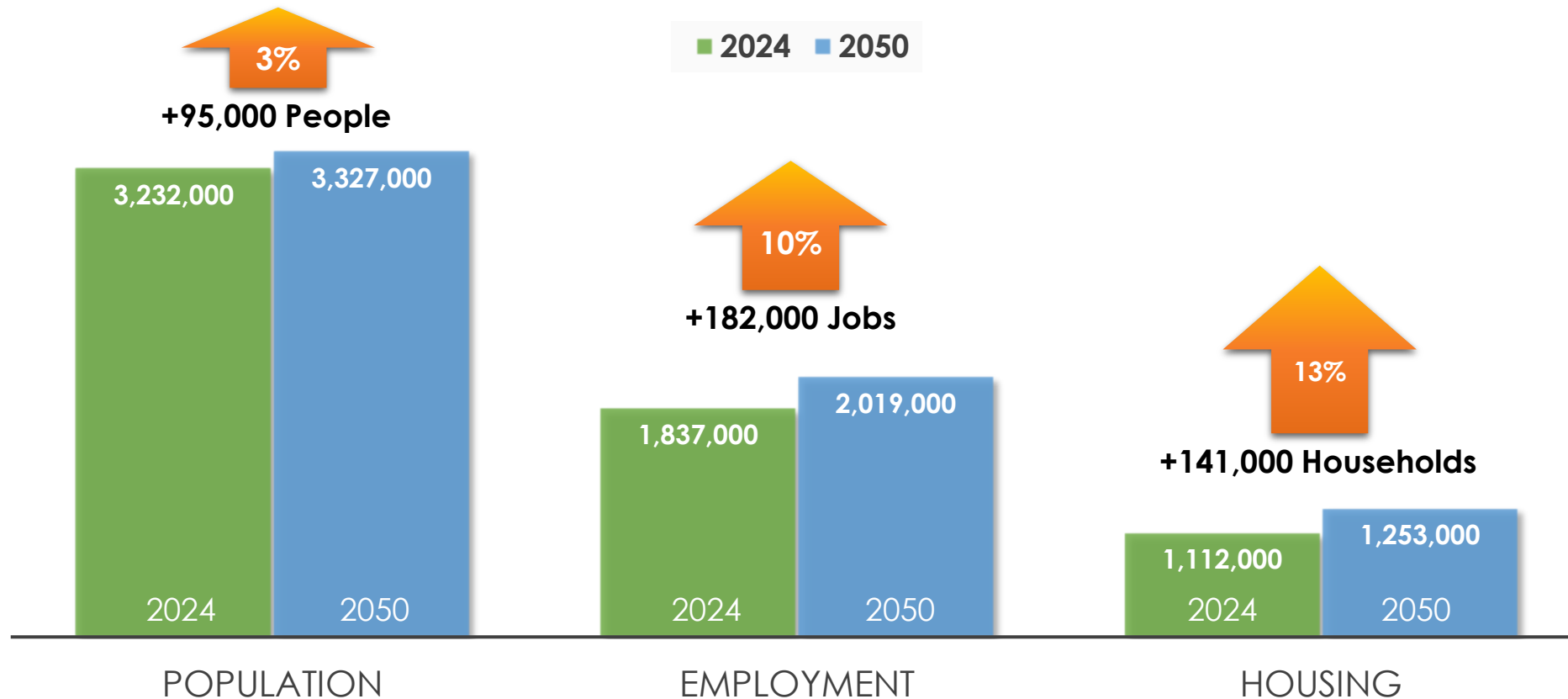

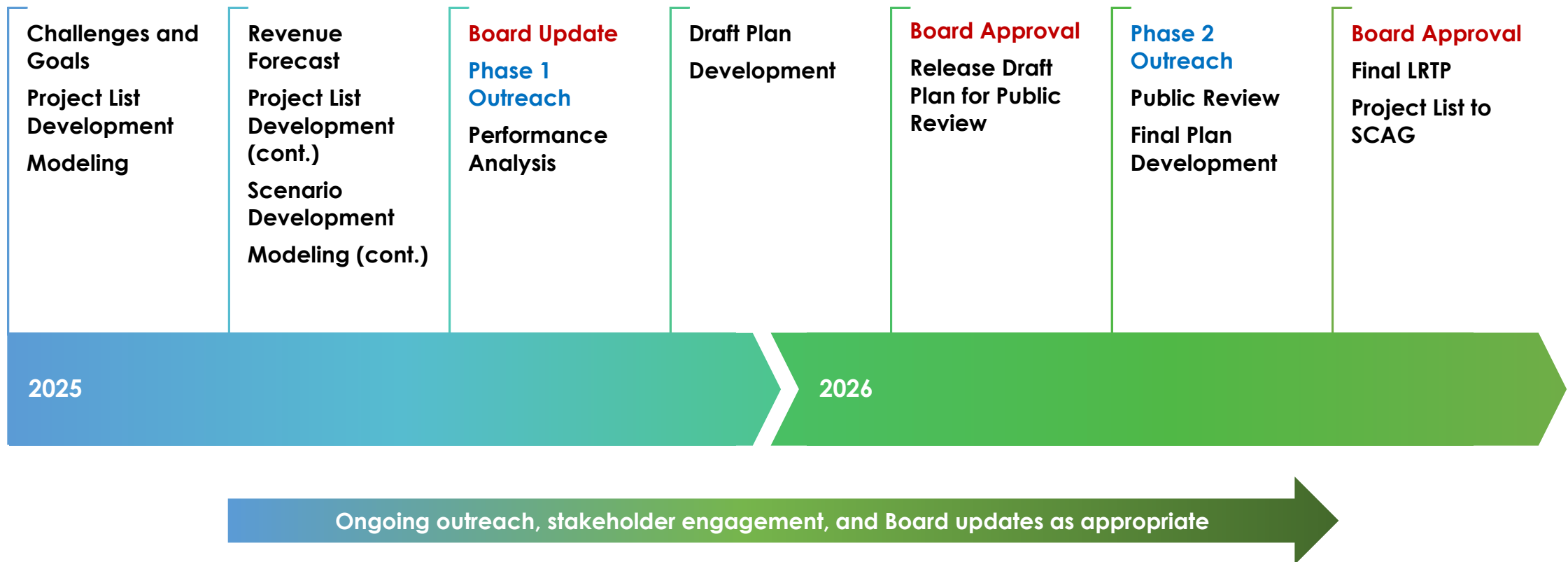
