BACKGROUND

The Anaheim Canyon train station was built in 1996 and is located near East La Palma Avenue and North Pacificenter Drive. The station is located near the Anaheim Canyon Business Center, which is one of the largest employment centers in Orange County for industrial, research and development, and technology activity. More than 2,600 companies are within this area.

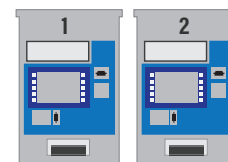
