BACKGROUND

The Fullerton train station was rebuilt in 1993 and is located near Harbor Boulevard and Santa Fe Avenue. Steps from the historic Spanish Colonial rail station, downtown Fullerton combines a sense of history with the fresh vibe of modern cuisine and shopping.

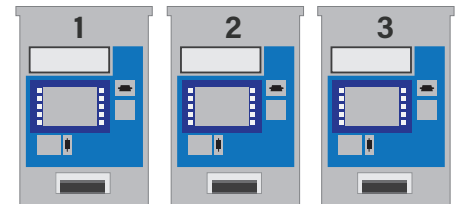
