BACKGROUND

The Orange train station, built in 1938, is located near Chapman Avenue and North Atchison Street. The station is conveniently located near the Plaza in Old Towne Orange and recognized as one of Orange's historic landmarks.

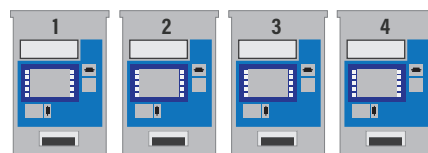
