1 TRACKS ARE FOR TRAINS!

They are private property. Walking, jogging or playing on or near the train tracks is considered trespassing and is illegal.

- TRAINS WILL NOT ALWAYS BLOW WARNING HORNS.

 Quiet Zones will soon be established in residential and business areas along the train tracks, so trains will no longer
- need to blow their horns.

 WARNING SIGNS SAVE LIVES!

 Approach all crossings with care and do not ignore any
 - warning signs or gates.
 As a motorist, never drive around gates.
 - As a pedestrian, always stop, look and listen for a train before crossing the tracks at a designated pedestrian crossing.
- 4 NEVER TRY TO BEAT A TRAIN!

 Trains can take up to half a mile to reach a complete stop.

 Trains cannot swerve to avoid people or cars and cannot stop quickly enough to avoid a collision.
