Travel on I-5 (San Diego Fwy) southbound and exit East Avenida Palizada in San Clemente at Exit 75. Continue on East Avenida Palizada for 0.8 mile and veer right onto Linda Lane until reaching the Parking Lot at 340-398 Linda Ln, San Clemente, CA 92672. Next walk along San Clemente Pedestrian Beach Trail to the beach and work area.

**18. Nature of Activity (Description of project, include all features)**

Emergency activities along the LOSSAN rail to avoid rail collapse through placement of rip rap rock and temporary access. Proposed shoreline protection activities include conducting rip-rap rock repair on existing rock revetments (Areas 1, 2, and 4), installation of a new shoreline protection structure at Area 4, temporary access for construction, and placement of sand for beach nourishment over the existing and new shoreline protection rock and structure. Installation of a catchment wall at Area 3. Sand placement is being requested through separate application for an individual Letter of Permission.

Impacts to WOUS: Area 1 (0 acre), Area 2 (0.095 acre temporary rock repair; 0.92 temporary access), Area 3 (0.006 acre permanent catchment wall), Area 4 (0.029 acre temporary access), totaling 1.05 acres (4,643 linear feet) impacts in non-wetland WOUS.

Emergency activities to protect the LOSSAN rail.
