PURCHASING

Prepaid passes are available at over one hundred local retailers plus local Ralphs, Vons, Pavilions and Northgate Markets. Visit <u>ocbus.com/buyapass</u> to purchase prepaid bus passes online, or to find a retailer where you can buy a pass. Passes may also be purchased via phone at 714-560-5932, weekdays between 8:00 am to 2:00 pm.

SENIOR & DISABLED FARES

- 1. Must show proof of age, disability or Medicare card to coach operator.
- 2. Senior citizens (age 60 & older) must show a valid driver's license, California DMV ID card, Medicare card or OCTA Senior Reduced Fare ID card as proof of age when purchasing and using reduced fares.
- 3. To obtain an OCTA Senior or Persons with Disabilities Reduced Fare ID card, visit <u>octa.net</u> for application and information.
- 4. Fares and policies are subject to change. Some restrictions apply. Passes are non-refundable, non-transferable and subject to OCTA's Schedule of Tariffs.

PREPAID BUS PASSES

30-Day passes are valid for 30 consecutive days, beginning on the first day of use, providing unlimited use on all local OC Bus routes. Passes are available for regular, youth, senior and disabled riders.

TOP 5 TIPS TO READING SCHEDULES

OC Bus schedules are designed to give you key information about bus routes and timing at major stops along the way. Use these tips to determine the best route and time for your trip.

Find your OC Bus route number and direction.
Major streets and destinations are noted in this area.

2 Check the days of the week the route operates and confirm direction of travel and the city or landmark where the route ends.

Scheduled departures are from the major bus stops listed along the top of the schedule.

4 When you see a row of dots (....) that means no service is provided.

5 A grey bar indicates that particular OC Bus trip does not offer service along the entire route.







The return trip is the reverse, except the bus stops may be on the other side of the street.

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Don't forget to tell all your friends what a great time you had and invite them to ride next time.

TRANSIT CHOICES

The Orange County Transportation Authority (OCTA) operates several public transit services throughout the county. They range from regular bus service and bus rapid transit to ACCESS shared-ride service and on-demand transit.



OC Bus is our primary bus service operating throughout Orange County with more than 50 routes and over 5,000 bus stops.



Bravo service is a limited stop service offered on our busiest routes. It only stops at major transfer points and destinations allowing for fast commutes.



OC ACCESS is a shared-ride service that is available to qualified applicants whose physical or cognitive limitations prevent them from utilizing the regular OC Bus fixed-route service.



OC FLEX is our neighborhood on-demand curb-to-curb transit service currently operating in South Orange County. For details visit <u>OCflex.com</u>.

RIDER SECURITY

We want to make sure that all our riders enjoy a safe and pleasant experience when riding OC Bus. Please follow these simple rules when riding!

RIDE SAFELY

- The bus may move before you are seated; always hold on and be prepared.
- When a seat is available, sit; do not remain standing. If standing, always hold on.
- Do not stand near or lean against the back door.
- Always remain behind the yellow or white line near the front of the bus.
- If using a wheelchair, always allow the bus operator to secure your wheelchair.

EXITING AT YOUR STOP

As your bus stop approaches, signal the driver to stop by ringing the chime or pulling the signal cord. When exiting the bus, go to the rear and press and release the yellow strips on the doors. Once the doors open, exit quickly and safely, allowing children to go first.

USING THE BIKE RACK

All OCTA buses are equipped with bike racks. Each bike rack holds three bikes. Racks are available on a first-come, first-served basis. If the rack is full, bikes are not permitted inside buses, except for the last trip of the day, unless it presents a safety concern. Acceptable bicycle specifications:

<u>Wheel Size</u> 20 – 29 inches in diameter

<u>Wheelbase</u> 44 inches maximum axle to axle

<u>Tire Width</u> No more than 2.35 inches maximum



BUS RIDING COURTESY

Please follow the simple rules below to help make bus travel pleasant for everyone.

- No smoking or eating on the bus. Electronic smoking devices, such as electronic cigarettes, are prohibited on any OC Bus.
- 2. Bringing drinks.

Drinks must be in a spill proof or covered container. No alcohol allowed.

- **3.** No combustable materials. No gas powered bicycles, scooters, car batteries, fireworks or other combustible materials are allowed on the bus.
- 4. Strollers must be folded prior to boarding the bus.
- 5. Surfboards are permitted as long as they do not exceed 6 feet, 6 inches in length.
- 6. Service animals are allowed to accompany persons with disabilities. That person is responsible for the actions of the animal while aboard the bus. Service animals cannot occupy seats and must remain on the floor at all times, making sure not to block the aisle, path of travel, access doors, or lift.

7. Devices with speakers.

All radios, mp3 players, cd players, and cell phones must be used with headphones.

8. No soliciting.

Handing out any written material, solicitation or advertisement is not allowed.

9. Front seats.

Please keep front seats available for disabled persons and senior citizens.

10. Your bus driver.

Do not talk to or distract the bus operator while a bus is moving.
