

About the Project

The Orange County Transportation Authority (OCTA), in coordination with Metrolink, is replacing the railroad bridge over San Juan Creek in the City of San Juan Capistrano to enhance safety and reduce maintenance needs. Once the new bridge is completed and train service is switched over, the existing bridge will be demolished. Construction is expected to be completed in early 2027.

Construction Activities

San Juan Creek Trail Update

Crews reopened the San Juan Creek Trail today, however, the trail is expected to close Monday, Sept. 30 and Tuesday, Oct. 1 to allow crews to complete the removal of boulders that are interfering with the construction of a new retaining wall. The public will continue to be notified in advance of any future intermittent trail closures.

Retaining Wall and Bridge Construction
Crews are expected to begin construction of
a retaining wall next week. Construction
activities include drilling, installing piles and
concrete pours several times a week through
the end of October. Construction vehicles will
access the location using Paseo Adelanto.

Concurrently, crews continue to install steel cages and pour concrete for work on the railroad bridge abutments.
