



SAN JUAN CREEK BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT



About the Project

The Orange County Transportation Authority (OCTA), in coordination with Metrolink, is replacing the railroad bridge over San Juan Creek in the City of San Juan Capistrano to enhance safety and reduce maintenance needs. Once the new bridge is completed and train service is switched over, the existing bridge will be demolished. Construction is expected to be completed in early 2027.

Upcoming: San Juan Creek Trail Closure

The San Juan Creek Trail is expected to be closed in November for an extended period of time. More information will be available in future communications.

Retaining Wall Construction

Crews are expected to begin drilling and pouring concrete for piles that will be installed for a new retaining wall being constructed next to the City Hall and Santa Margarita Water District facilities. This work is expected to continue through the end of the year. Construction vehicles will access the location using Paseo Adelanto.

This work may be loud. The schedule is subject to change due to inclement weather or unforeseen operational issues.
