



SAN JUAN CREEK BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT



About the Project

The Orange County Transportation Authority (OCTA), in coordination with Metrolink, is replacing the railroad bridge over San Juan Creek in the City of San Juan Capistrano to enhance safety and reduce maintenance needs. Once the new bridge is completed and train service is switched over, the existing bridge will be demolished. Construction is expected to be completed in early 2027.

Update: San Juan Creek Trail Closure

For the safety of crews and trail users, a segment of the **San Juan Creek Trail will be closed on Monday, Nov. 25 from 6 a.m. to 5 p.m.** to allow crews to continue constructing four retaining walls adjacent to the trail. Click on [detour map](#) to enlarge.

An additional trail closure is expected in mid-December to allow crews to complete construction of all four walls before the end of the year.
