



# SAN JUAN CREEK BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT



## About the Project

The Orange County Transportation Authority (OCTA), in coordination with Metrolink, is replacing the railroad bridge over San Juan Creek in the City of San Juan Capistrano to enhance safety and reduce maintenance needs. Once the new bridge is completed and train service is switched over, the existing bridge will be demolished. Construction is expected to be completed in early 2027.

- **Wednesday, Dec. 18 to Friday, Dec. 20**
- **Thursday, Dec. 26 and Friday, Dec. 27**
- **Monday, Dec. 30**
- **Thursday, Jan. 2 and Friday, Jan. 3**
