

About the Project

The Orange County Transportation Authority (OCTA), in coordination with Metrolink, is replacing the railroad bridge over San Juan Creek in the City of San Juan Capistrano to enhance safety and reduce maintenance needs. Once the new bridge is completed and train service is switched over, the existing bridge will be demolished. Construction is expected to be completed in early 2027.

San Juan Creek Trail Closure Updates

For the safety of crews and trail users, a segment of the San Juan Creek Trail will be closed intermittently during weekdays to allow crews to continue constructing four retaining walls and performing work on the new railroad bridge adjacent to the trail.

The trail is set to close on the dates listed below from 6 a.m. to 5 p.m. and will reopen to pedestrians and bicyclists at the end of each work day.

- Thursday, Jan. 2 **
- Friday, Jan. 3
- Monday, Jan. 6 and Tuesday, Jan. 7
- Wednesday, Jan. 8 **
- Thursday, Jan. 9 to Wednesday, Jan. 15

This work may be loud. Schedule is subject to change due to inclement weather or unforeseen operational issues.
