



SAN JUAN CREEK BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT



About the Project

The Orange County Transportation Authority (OCTA), in coordination with Metrolink, is replacing the railroad bridge over San Juan Creek in the City of San Juan Capistrano to enhance safety and reduce maintenance needs. Once the new bridge is completed and train service is switched over, the existing bridge will be demolished. Construction is expected to be completed in early 2027.

Construction Activities

Concrete Pours for Railroad Bridge Improvements

Crews are continuing to construct bridge abutments for the new railroad bridge, which requires a day of intermittent concrete pours scheduled for Wednesday, Jan. 29. To accommodate this activity, a series of concrete trucks will be accessing the construction site from Trabuco Creek Trail. During times when concrete trucks are on the trail, pedestrians and bicyclists will be briefly stopped by flaggers until the trail is clear.

This work may be loud. Schedule is subject to change due to inclement weather or unforeseen operational issues.
