



# SAN JUAN CREEK BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT



## About the Project

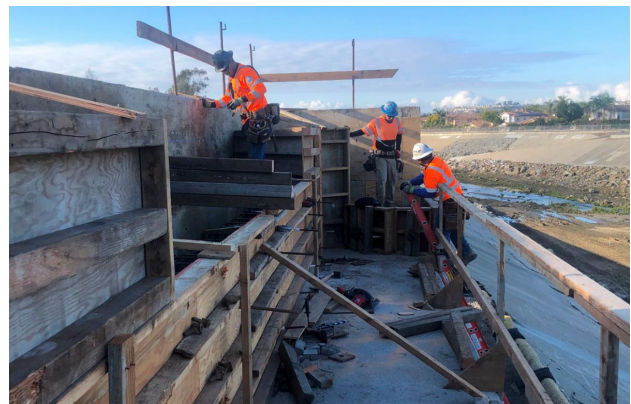
The Orange County Transportation Authority (OCTA), in coordination with Metrolink, is replacing the railroad bridge over San Juan Creek in the City of San Juan Capistrano to enhance safety and reduce maintenance needs. Once the new bridge is completed and train service is switched over, the existing bridge will be demolished. Construction is expected to be completed in early 2027.

## Construction Activities

### Railroad Bridge Improvements Continue

Crews are making progress on the construction of two new railroad bridge abutments. They continued “formwork,” a term in construction that refers to a temporary structure used to support and shape concrete until it attains sufficient strength to be self-supporting. The photos shown below depict the construction team performing formwork on a bridge abutment before concrete is poured later.
