



SAN JUAN CREEK BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT



About the Project

The Orange County Transportation Authority (OCTA), in coordination with Metrolink, is replacing the railroad bridge over San Juan Creek in the City of San Juan Capistrano to enhance safety and reduce maintenance needs. Once the new bridge is completed and train service is switched over, the existing bridge will be demolished. Construction is expected to be completed in early 2027.

Update: San Juan Creek Trail Intermittent Closures

A segment of the San Juan Creek Trail will be closed intermittently beginning as soon as **Monday, March 17 for approximately three weeks** to allow crews to continue constructing retaining walls adjacent to the trail. To accommodate this activity, pedestrians and bicyclists will be briefly stopped by flaggers until the trail is clear.

This work may be loud. Schedule is subject to change due to inclement weather or unforeseen operational issues.
