

About the Project

The Orange County Transportation Authority (OCTA), in coordination with Metrolink, is replacing the railroad bridge over San Juan Creek in the City of San Juan Capistrano to enhance safety and reduce maintenance needs. Once the new bridge is completed and train service is switched over, the existing bridge will be demolished. Construction is expected to be completed in early 2027.

San Juan Creek Trail Update

The San Juan Creek Trail is expected to remain open under flagging conditions where crews will intermittently stop trail users while work around the bikeway underpass is underway. A short-term closure of the trail is planned for mid- August for welding activities. More information will be available in future communications.

Construction Activities

Weekend Construction Schedule

Crews are continuing to install deck pans and perform other activities from the creek during daytime hours between 6 a.m. and 4 p.m. Saturday work is expected to continue through Aug. 9.

Upcoming Nighttime Track Work

Crews are mobilizing equipment to the site as they prepare to remove the existing set-out track south of Del Obispo Street. Track removal is anticipated to begin in August and will require a temporary lane closure on Del Obispo Street between Paseo Adelanto and Camino Capistrano. Additional details will be shared in future updates.

This work may be loud. This schedule is subject to change due to inclement weather or unforeseen operational issues.
