


About the Project

The Orange County Transportation Authority (OCTA), in coordination with Metrolink, is replacing the railroad bridge over San Juan Creek in the City of San Juan Capistrano to enhance safety and reduce maintenance needs. Once the new bridge is completed and train service is switched over, the existing bridge will be demolished. Construction is expected to be completed in early 2027.

Eastbound Del Obispo Lane Closure through Monday, Aug. 18

Crews are expected to complete the removal of railroad ties around the Del Obispo crossing by early next week, at which time all lanes on Del Obispo Street will be open. Until then, the eastbound lane on Del Obispo between Paseo Adelanto and Camino Capistrano are expected to be closed nightly from 7:30 p.m. to 5 a.m. through Monday, Aug. 18.




Construction Activities

San Juan Creek Demobilization

Starting the week of Aug. 25, crews are expected to begin demobilization efforts from San Juan Creek in preparation for the wet season. This will require all materials and equipment to be moved and the channel restored to its original condition.

Tree Trimming Maintenance

Crews are expected to trim trees within the rail right of way to ensure the rail line remains safe and operational. This daytime work is anticipated to begin on Tuesday, Aug. 19 and is expected to take approximately one week.
