

About the Project

The Orange County Transportation Authority (OCTA), in coordination with Metrolink, is replacing the railroad bridge over San Juan Creek in the City of San Juan Capistrano to enhance safety and reduce maintenance needs. Once the new bridge is completed and train service is switched over, the existing bridge will be demolished. Construction is expected to be completed in early 2027.

Upcoming Closure of San Juan Creek Trail

The San Juan Creek Trail is expected to close beginning as soon as Wednesday, Sept. 25 through Saturday, Sept. 28 from 6:30 a.m. to 6 p.m.

The intermittent closure is necessary to allow crews to safely remove boulders that were recently discovered near the trail, which are interfering with the construction of a new retaining wall.

Trail users are asked to plan ahead as they will be detoured to Camino Capistrano, Del Obispo Street and the Trabuco Creek Trail. Bicyclists are encouraged to walk their bikes along Del Obispo Street. View closure and detour map here.
