

To address freeway travel demand, OCTA in partnership with Caltrans District 12 is implementing the San Diego Freeway (I-5) Widening project from SR-73 to El Toro Road in southern Orange County.

SIENNA SEGMENT Oso Parkway to Alicia Parkway

Estimated Construction Schedule: Mid-2019 to Late 2023

SEGMENT OVERVIEW

New northbound and southbound general purpose lanes help keep south Orange County moving. The improvements provide connectivity to local communities, businesses and schools, including Mission Viejo High School.

ROADWAY

- Increase capacity / improve mobility
- Add general purpose lane, northbound and southbound from Oso to Alicia Parkways

STRUCTURE

- Reconstruct La Paz Road interchange
- Modify six on-and off-ramps at Oso Parkway
- Add new sound and retaining walls

OPERATIONAL

- Convert carpool lanes to continuous access
- Add new and re-establish auxiliary lanes, improving operations

DETAILS

LENGTH: 2.6 miles



ADJACENT CITIES: Mission Viejo, Lake Forrest & Laguna Hills

PALM SEGMENT Alicia Parkway to El Toro Road

Estimated Construction Schedule: Mid-2020 to Mid-2024

SEGMENT OVERVIEW

The projects adds a general purpose lane and extends a second carpool lane in both directions. Lake Forest and Laguna Hills shops and restaurants are accessible, as well as MemorialCare Saddleback Medical Center.

ROADWAY

- Increase capacity / improve mobility
- Widen freeway, northbound and southbound
- Extend second carpool lane between Alicia Parkway and El Toro Road

STRUCTURE

- Reconstruct Los Alisos Boulevard bridge
- Add new retaining and sound walls
- Modify six on-and off-ramps

OPERATIONAL

- Convert carpool lanes to continuous access
- Add new and re-establish auxiliary lanes, improving operations
- Install new overhead signs


DETAILS

LENGTH: 1.8 miles

ADJACENT CITIES: Lake Forest, Laguna Hills & Laguna Woods

TOTAL ESTIMATED COST: \$166 million
