




CTFP Overview




- Offers M2 competitive grants for:
 - Regional Capacity Program
 - Signal Synchronization Program
 - Transit Programs
 - Environmental Cleanup Program
- Projects must meet M2 Eligibility and local match requirements



Regional Capacity Program (Project O)




- Funds roadway improvements on major arterials:
 - \$406 million programmed to date
 - 226 project phases
 - 75% delivered and 25% in progress
 - Benefits delivered:
 - 92 new turn lanes and 164 operational improvements
 - Bike lanes, pedestrian facilities, raised medians, bus turnouts, etc.
- Comprised of 3 funding programs:
 - Arterial Capacity Enhancements (ACE)
 - Intersection Capacity Enhancements (ICE)
 - Freeway Arterial/Streets Transitions (FAST)
- Current Status:
 - 15th call issued August 2024
 - Funding recommendations: Spring 2025



Signal Synchronization Program (Project P)



- Funds signal coordination across cities:
 - \$150 million programmed to date
 - 231 project phases for 117 projects
 - 79% delivered and 21% in progress
 - Benefits delivered:
 - Average speed improved by 14%
 - Number of stops reduced by 29%
 - GHG emissions reduced by nearly 1.3 billion pounds
- Funds:
 - Primary Implementation (capital)
 - Operations and Maintenance (O&M)
- Current Status:
 - 15th call issued August 2024
 - Funding recommendations: Spring 2025



Transit Programs



- Project S (Extensions to Metrolink)
 - \$732K programmed to date
 - 4 projects (bus and station van service)
 - No calls planned in the immediate future
- Project W (Safe Transit Stops)
 - \$3.1 million programmed to date
 - Passenger waiting amenities at 122 bus stops
 - **53% delivered** and 47% in progress
 - Improvements delivered:
 - 67 bus shelters
 - 82 benches
 - 155 trash receptacles
 - 22 curb ramps
 - Current Status:
 - Assessing timing for the next call







Transit Programs (continued)





- Project V (Community Based Transit)
 - \$96 million programmed to date
 - 49 projects and 10 planning studies
 - Over 4.6 million boardings to date
 - Current Status:
 - 5th call completed in September awarding
 \$43 million for 13 projects
 - Special Event: 9 services
 - Seasonal: 6 services
 - Local Circulator: 4 services
 - On-Demand: 3 services
 - Commuter/Rail Feeder: 1 service





Environmental Cleanup Program (Project X)



 Funds street and highway related water quality improvements countywide:

Tier 1 Program

- Visible forms of pollutants
- \$40.3 million programmed to date
- 233 projects
 - 86% delivered and 14% in progress
- 69.5 million gallons of trash captured

Current Status:

- 14th call completed in October awarding \$3.7 million for 11 projects
- 15th call anticipated in early 2025

Environmental Cleanup Program (continued)



Tier 2 Program

- Large-scale BMP construction
- Mitigates heavy metals, organic chemicals, and sediment
- \$34.9 million programmed to date
- 26/projects/
 - /-//82%/delivered/and/18%/planned
- -/ Treatment of 157 million gallons of water annually (potential)

- \$7 call completed in October awarding \$7 million for 4 projects
- ///Assessing timing for the next call

- CTFP Guidelines
 - Last update approved by the Board 8/12/2024
 - Amended with each call for projects
- Call for Projects
 - Annually & Periodically (depending on program and economic conditions)
- Project Monitoring
 - March & September Semi-Annual Review
- Oversight and Authorization of Project Costs and Payments
- Measure M2 Quarterly Progress Report
