






# Sources of Revenues Ten-Year Estimate (\$ millions)

#### Formula Programs

- State Transportation Improvement Program
  - Provides funding for state transportation funds for highway, intercity rail, and transit improvements
  - \$2.198 billion available
  - OCTA's Share \$237 million

#### 8 OCTA projects for \$261 million

- I-5 Improvements from SR-73 to Oso Parkway (Segment 1) \$74 million
- I-5 Improvements from Alicia Parkway to El Toro Road (Segment 3) \$70 million
- I-5 Improvements from SR-73 to El Toro Road (replacement planting/landscaping) \$6 million
- I-5 Improvements from I-405 to SR-55 \$12.628 million
- SR-55 Orange County Central Corridor Improvement from I-405 to I-5 \$80 million
- SR-57 Truck Climbing Lane Phase I Lambert Road Interchange Improvements \$9 million
- SR-57 Truck Climbing Lane Phase II- Lambert Road to County Line \$4 million
- Planning, Programming, and Monitoring \$5 million

## Formula Programs

- State of Good Repair Formula
  - Provides flexible funding for bus capital and operations
  - \$105 million available
  - OCTA share \$5.7 million
    - 10 Hydrogen Buses \$5.6 million
    - Heating and Ventilation Unit at Anaheim Bus Base \$1 million

## Formula Programs

- Local Partnership Program Formula
  - Provides funding to existing self-help counties and agencies that have passed transportation fee programs.
  - \$200 million available
  - OCTA's share \$18 million
    - I-5 Improvements, State Route 73 to Oso Parkway

#### Competitive Programs

- Local Partnership Program Competitive (\$300 million)
  - Provides funding to existing self-help counties and agencies that have passed transportation fee programs.
  - 91 applications requested \$901 million

#### OCTA award

- Orange County Signal Synchronization Project (OCTA led Project P)
- \$6.845 million awarded

## Competitive Programs

- Solutions for Congested Corridors (\$1.0 billion)
  - Provides funding for a balanced set of transportation, environmental, and community access improvements to reduce congestion
  - 32 Applications for \$2.500 billion in requests
  - OCTA requested \$101.9 million
    - Traffic Signal Synchronization \$12.000 million
    - Bravo! Main Street Rapid Bus \$4.330 million
    - Four Active Transportation Projects-\$3.589 million
  - OCTA was awarded \$19.9 million
  - OCTA pursuing \$70 million for SR-55 HOV lane

- Trade Corridor Enhancement Program (1.341 billion)
  - Provides funding for freight-related projects
  - 43 Applications for \$1.957 billion in requests
  - City of Brea Lambert Interchange Project
  - Awarded \$65.7 million
- Transit Intercity Rail Capital Program(\$2.400 billion)
  - Provides funding for transformative capital improvements that modernize intercity, commuter, and urban rail systems, and bus transit systems.
  - 47 applications requested \$10.9 billion
  - Electric-Rapid Orange County \$26.413 million
  - Not awarded

## How did we do?

- OCTA Requested a total of \$480 million for Capital
  - Formula
    - STIP \$260 million
    - LPP Formula \$18.2 million
    - SB 1 SGR \$5.7 million
  - Competitive
    - TCEP \$65.7 million
    - SCCP \$19.9 million
    - LPP \$6.85 million
- Total awarded/programmed so far: \$376.35 million
