M2 Natural Community Conservation Plan/Habitat Conservation Plan (Conservation Plan)

SECOND ANNUAL REPORT





- Measure M2 (OC Go) approved November 2006
- Innovative Freeway Environmental Mitigation Program (EMP)
 - Offsets biological impacts of 13 OC Go freeway projects
 - Purchase of conservation lands (Preserves)
 - Provide funding for habitat restoration
- Approximately 5% of the OC Go freeway program revenue


- Environmental Documents

CCTA Preserves and Restoration Projects




- Seven Preserves acquired as permanent open space


