OC Streetcar Construction 86% Complete

OCTA's board received a quarterly update on the OC Streetcar, which is now approximately 86% complete.

The OC Streetcar will be Orange County's first modern electric streetcar, running along a 4.1-mile route between the Santa Ana Regional Transportation Center and Harbor Boulevard in Garden Grove. The project will improve transit connectivity and accessibility, increase transit options, relieve congestion, and provide benefits to the community and traveling public.

The OC Streetcar will offer an additional affordable and convenient transit option, connecting with several of the busiest OC Bus routes and Metrolink commuter rail, in one of the nation's most densely populated areas, while producing zero emissions.

Recent progress on the OC Streetcar includes:

- The Santa Ana River and Westminster bridges are complete
- Installation of all tracks and OC Streetcar poles are complete
- Canopies are installed at all station platforms
- All eight vehicles are complete and in storage
