Fact Sheet: Project O Regional Capacity Program and Project P Traffic Signal Synchronization Program 2024 Call for Projects

Call for Projects (Call) Scope

<u>Project O</u>: The Project O Regional Capacity Program (RCP) provides funding for improvements to the Orange County Master Plan of Arterial Highways (MPAH). The program provides for intersection improvements (ICE), mid-block widening (ACE), and interchange improvements (FAST) in an effort to help improve street operations and reduce congestion.

<u>Project P</u>: The Project P Regional Traffic Signal Synchronization Program (RTSSP) provides funding for signal synchronization improvements to the Orange County MPAH. The program provides for multi-agency, corridor-based signal synchronization throughout Orange County.

Estimated Funding Available

The Orange County Transportation Authority's (OCTA) Board of Directors (Board) approved a total funding target of approximately \$45 million for Project O and Project P for programming in fiscal years 2024-2025 through 2026-2027.
